



Government Degree College for Women, Srikalahasti, affiliated to Sri Venkateswara University, Tirupati, was inaugurated on 13th August 1988 by the Government of Andhra Pradesh. The college was established with a strong commitment to extending higher education to women from rural and economically underprivileged backgrounds in the Srikalahasti region. Guided by the motto "Vidya Dadati Vinayam" ("Knowledge gives obedience"), the institution has consistently endeavored to deliver value-driven education and foster an organizational culture supporting holistic development.

The institution was re-accredited by NAAC with a B+ grade (2.73 GPA on a 4-point scale, Cycle-2) on 24th September 2019, demonstrating its commitment to continuous quality enhancement. Since its inception, the college has focused on empowering women through education, striving to address the socio-economic and literacy challenges prevailing in the locality. It prioritizes motivating students towards higher studies and excellence in personal and professional spheres, while nurturing a culture of persistence and self-reliance. Various skill-oriented programmes and initiatives are in place to foster creative and critical thinking skills among students, with special emphasis on career development and innovation.

Skill enhancement initiatives include extensive JKC and APSSDC training, campus recruitment orientation, computer and communication skills development, and regular career guidance sessions. The NSS units actively organize cleanliness campaigns, community service, and field activities. The institution supports internships, linking students with both short-term (145 students) and long-term (151 students) corporate and research experiences. The Chemistry and English Departments have established fruitful MoUs with industry and academic partners.

### **Academic Programmes and Admissions**

For the academic year 2022-23, a total of 120 UG and PG students were admitted. Programmes offered are BA (HEP), BCom (General), BCom (CA), BSc (MPCS, MSCS, MBZc, MPC), MCom, and MSc (Zoology), maintaining a strong pass percentage of 88%.
